

## RESET 1 – Reset Priorities (Haggai 1:1-11)

- \* God wasn't \_\_\_\_\_ their prosperity; He was \_\_\_\_\_ prosperity becoming their \_\_\_\_\_.
- \* The pursuit of worldly success \_\_\_\_\_ of God \_\_\_\_\_ satisfies; in fact, it produces deep spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_.
- \* God will \_\_\_\_\_ you experience that as His way of \_\_\_\_\_ you back.
